Waller County is a rapidly growing part of the greater Houston-Galveston region in terms of population and employment. To accommodate this growth, Waller County along with the cities of Brookshire, Hempstead, Katy, Pattison, Prairie View and Waller, the Texas Department of Transportation, and the Houston-Galveston Area Council (H-GAC) are working together to identify and analyze the transportation issues in Waller County.

The 18-month study will produce a transportation plan that recommends projects to improve access to jobs, homes, and services now and in the future.

The meeting is a come and go open house. English and Spanish speakers will be available to gather input and answer questions.

H-GAC is designated by the State of Texas as the region's MPO for transportation planning in Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, and Waller Counties.
